ALL CLASSES OPEN TO ALL AGES AND EITHER HORSE OR PONY



CLASS 1 – Tiny trotting poles **

Trotting poles and tiny cross poles for the beginners - can be on or off lead-rein

CLASS 2 – Ride and Run **

Trotting poles and tiny cross poles for the beginners. Rider jumps their round then runs around course again, this time on foot (without their pony) – can be on or off lead rein

CLASS 3 – Little Jumpers **

Jumps max 30cm – can be on or off leading rein - prizes for best independent rider and lead rein rider

** Prize for overall best fancy dress in the above three classes

CLASS 4 – Mini stakes

Jumps Max 45cm. One round with second half of course timed.

CLASS 5 – Novice stakes

Jumps Max 55cm. One round with second half of course timed.

CLASS 6 – 70 cm Show Jumping

Jumps Max 80cm. One round with second half of course timed.

CLASS 7 - Small Accumulator (see rules)

Selection of Jumps between 50cm and 70cm – rider with most points is the winner. 80cm Joker fence

CLASS 8 – 80 cm Show Jumping

Jumps Max 80cm. One round with second half of course timed.

CLASS 9 – 90cm Show Jumping

Jumps Max 90cm. One round with second half of course timed.

CLASS 10 – Accumulator (see rules)

Selection of Jumps between 80cm and 1m – rider with most points is the winner. 110cm Joker fence

CLASS 11 – Open Jumping

Jumps Max 105cm. One round with second half of course timed.

RULES

Accumulator Rules

- Classes 7 and 10. Riders will have 45 seconds to accumulate as many points as they can. Each jump will be worth a certain number of points. Each jump will be able to be jumped in both directions and can be jumped a maximum of 3 times. Joker will be worth 200 points but 200 points will be deducted from final score if it is knocked down. Whistle will go after 45 seconds and rider must go over finish line to stop the clock. If there is equality of points, time will decide the winner.

General Rules

- Stunning Rosettes will be awarded 1st – 6th
- Prizes in all classes for 1st – 3rd
- Doddie Weir was a former member of the Duke of Buccleuch Pony Club. A substantial donation from the proceeds of this event will be made to **My Name's Doddie Foundation**
- Open to all. No need to be a member of a pony club. Competitors who are not members of a Pony Club are strongly advised to have insurance of AT LEAST 3rd party liability.
- Neither the organisers, nor Duke of Buccleuch Hunt Branch of the Pony Club, nor any agent employee or representative of these bodies accept any liability for accident, loss, damage, or injury, or illness to horses, riders, dogs, spectators, land or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach or contract, or in any other way whatsoever.
- Riders and horses/ponies take part at their own risk. Horses and ponies must be 4 years and over.
- Any rider deemed to be abusing their pony/ horse will be asked to leave the event by either the judge or the organisers
- Hats must be fastened at all times when mounted and must be of standard PAS 015 1998, EN 1384 1996, BS EN 1384 1997 all with BSI Kitemark, Snell E2001, all with official label and number, AS/NZS 3838 1998, or AS/NZS3838 2003 with SAI Global.
- Please note: This is a “Fun Show” and the organisers would be most appreciative if competitors were “genuinely eligible” for classes to allow less experienced riders a chance to shine at their own level.
- Horses and ponies must not be left unattended whilst tied to trailers / lorries
- Please tidy up after your horse or pony in the lorry park by using the muck skips provided.
- Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times and are not allowed into the cafe area
- The Judge's decision is final
- By entering this competition you agreeing to abide by the above rules.
