Class 1 - 10:00 - Indoor Arena - Clear Round

Open To All

British Showjumping Tack Rules, Conduct Rules & Welfare Policy apply.

70cm

Entry Fee = £8.00 (Pre-Entry £6.00)

Class 2a - Indoor Arena - Club - Senior 70cm

Club (Single Phase). Speed 300mpm. Start Height 70cm.

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Open to non-registered or British Showjumping Club competitors on horses and ponies. Senior riders should be turning 17 years old or older in the current year. Stallions are not permitted to jump in any Club classes.

Qualifying period: 1st July 2018 to 30th June 2019

Numbers to qualify: The Top 20 from each of the four height category league tables, will qualify for the National Club Championships held at the British Showjumping National Championships. Club registered horse(or pony)/rider combinations are eligible to qualify and in more than one height category.

Points

1st = 12, 2nd = 10, 3rd = 8, 4th = 6, 5th = 4, 6th = 3. Double Clear Points = 3.

Points are allocated depending on the number of starters; every one in five registered starters is eligible for points. If you gain a double clear you will receive three points regardless of starters. If a combination competes in more than two consecutive height classes per show day only the points from the bigger classes will be graded.

Pre entry available through horse monkey. Pre enter to save, entries will be accepted on the day.

Prizes: 1st: £12.00, 2nd: £10.00, 3rd: £5.00, Total: £27.00. **Entry Fee = £12.00 (Pre-Entry £10.00)**

Class 2b - Indoor Arena - **Club - Junior 70cm**

Club (Single Phase). Speed 300mpm. Start Height 70cm.

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Open to non-registered or British Showjumping Club competitors on horses and ponies. Junior riders should be turning 16 years old or younger in the current year. Stallions are not permitted to jump in any Club classes.

Qualifying period: 1st July 2018 to 30th June 2019

Numbers to qualify: The Top 20 from each of the four height category league tables, will qualify for the National Club Championships held at the British Showjumping National Championships. Club registered horse(or pony)/rider combinations are eligible to qualify and in more than one height category.

Points

1st = 12, 2nd = 10, 3rd = 8, 4th = 6, 5th = 4, 6th = 3. Double Clear Points = 3.

Points are allocated depending on the number of starters; every one in five registered starters is eligible for points. If you gain a double clear you will receive three points regardless of starters. If a combination competes in more than two consecutive height classes per show day only the points from the bigger classes will be graded.

Pre entry available through horse monkey. Pre enter to save, entries will be accepted on the day.

Prizes: 1st: £12.00, 2nd: £10.00, 3rd: £5.00, Total: £27.00. **Entry Fee = £12.00 (Pre-Entry £10.00)**

Class 3 - Indoor Arena - **Senior 75cm Open**

Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 75cm.

For registered horses in Grades: A, B & C. Ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Pre enter through Horse Monkey and save. Entries will be accepted on the day.

Prizes: 1st: £20.00, 2nd: £16.00, 3rd: £15.00, 4th: £15.00, Total: £66.00. **Entry Fee = £15.00 (Pre-Entry £13.00)**

Class 4a - Indoor Arena - **Dodson & Horrell 85cms National Amateur Championship Qualifier - First Round**

Rule 318. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 85cm.

Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

For registered horses to be ridden by Full, Associate or Junior Members excluding any rider listed on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2018 (assigned for the qualifying period) and any horse/rider combination listed on the British Showjumping Silver League as of 31st March 2018 (assigned for the qualifying Period).

Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team (4* or 5* Nations Cup in the last 10 years, World, European Championships & Olympic Games) are not eligible. Pony Riders, Children, Juniors and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/International Team Events and European Championships in the last five years are not eligible (excluding Veterans and Para Teams).

Qualifies for: 85cms National Amateur Second Rounds.

Qualifying period: 1st September-31st August inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horse/rider combinations which jump clear in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least five 85cm National Amateur First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the respective height classes at the National Amateur Championships. Horses which jump clear in the first round followed by a clear round in the jump off, in at least one 85cm National Amateur First Round Competition held in the qualifying period, will qualify to compete in the National Amateur 85cm Second Round competition.

Pre enter through Horse Monkey and save. Entries will be accepted on the day.

Prizes: 1st: £20.00, 2nd: £18.00, 3rd: £16.00, 4th: £15.00, Total: £69.00. **Entry Fee = £15.00 (Pre-Entry £13.00)**

Class 4b - Indoor Arena - **Senior 85cm Open**

Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 85cm.

For registered horses in Grades: A, B & C. Ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Pre enter through Horse Monkey and save. Entries will be accepted on the day.

Prizes: 1st: £20.00, 2nd: £18.00, 3rd: £16.00, 4th: £15.00, Total: £69.00. **Entry Fee = £15.00 (Pre-Entry £13.00)**

Class 5a - Indoor Arena - **Dodson & Horrell 95cms National Amateur Championship Qualifier - First Round**

Rule 320. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 95cm.

Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

For registered horses to be ridden by Full, Associate or Junior Members excluding any rider listed on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2018 (assigned for the qualifying Period) and any horse/rider combination listed on the British Showjumping Silver League of 31st March 2018 (assigned for the qualifying Period). Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team (4* or 5* Nations Cup in the last 10 years, World, European Championships & Olympic Games) are not eligible. Pony Riders, Children, Juniors and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/International Team Events and European Championships in the last five years are not eligible (excluding Veterans and Para Teams).

Qualifies for: 95cms National Amateur Second Rounds

Qualifying period: 1st September - 31st August inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horse/rider combinations which jump clear in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least five 95cm National Amateur First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the respective height classes at the National Amateur Championships. Horses which jump clear in the first round followed by a clear round in the jump off, in at least one 95cm National Amateur First Round Competition held in the qualifying period, will qualify to compete in the National Amateur 95cm Second Round competition.

Pre enter through Horse Monkey and save. Entries will be accepted on the day.

Prizes: 1st: £20.00, 2nd: £18.00, 3rd: £16.00, 4th: £16.00, Total: £70.00. **Entry Fee = £16.00 (Pre-Entry £14.00)**

Class 5b - Indoor Arena - **Senior 95cm Open**

Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 95cm.

For registered horses in Grades: A, B & C. Ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Pre enter through Horse Monkey and save. Entries will be accepted on the day.

Prizes: 1st: £20.00, 2nd: £18.00, 3rd: £16.00, 4th: £16.00, Total: £70.00. **Entry Fee = £16.00 (Pre-Entry £14.00)**

Class 6 - Indoor Arena - **Nupafeed Supplements Senior Discovery First Round/1m Open**

Rule 314. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.00m.

Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Discovery:

a) For Horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 225 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 314.6.

b) For all horses born on or after 1 January 2014 irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of five years or under in the same calendar year as the Discovery Final - in accordance with Rule 314.6.

Qualifies for: Nupafeed Supplements Discovery Championship Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horses that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four First Round competitions held in any qualifying period, will qualify to compete in and attend four Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain a double clear round qualification.

1.00m Open:

For registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

If combined with an open:

In Category 1 Shows and in the event of 30 starters or more the Open and the Discovery section will be split with two sets of prize money awarded.

In Category 2 Shows the sections must always be split with two sets of prize money awarded, irrespective of starters.

Pre enter through Horse Monkey and save. Entries will be accepted on the day.

Prizes: 1st: £30.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £16.00, 4th: £16.00, 5th: £16.00, Total: £98.00. **Entry Fee = £16.00 (Pre-Entry £14.00)**

Class 7a - Indoor Arena - **Dodson & Horrell 1.05m National Amateur Championship Qualifier - First Round**

Rule 322. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.05m.

Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

For registered horses to be ridden by Full, Associate or Junior Members excluding any rider listed on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2018 (assigned for the qualifying Period). Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team (4* or 5* Nations Cup in the last 10 years, World, European Championships & Olympic Games) are not eligible. Pony Riders, Children, Juniors and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/International Team Events and European Championships in the last five years are not eligible (excluding Veterans and Para Teams).

Qualifies for: 1.05m National Amateur Second Rounds.

Qualifying period: 1st September-31st August inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horse/rider combinations which jump clear in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least five 1.05m National Amateur First Round competitions held in the qualifying period, will qualify to compete in the respective height classes at the National Amateur Championships. Horses which jump clear in the first round followed by a clear round in the jump off, in at least one 1.05m National Amateur First Round Competition held in the qualifying period, will qualify to compete in the National Amateur 1.05m Second Round competition.

Pre enter through Horse Monkey and save. Entries will be accepted on the day.

Prizes: 1st: £35.00, 2nd: £25.00, 3rd: £18.00, 4th: £16.00, 5th: £16.00, Total: £110.00. **Entry Fee = £16.00 (Pre-Entry £14.00)**

Class 7b - Indoor Arena - **Senior 1.05m Open**

Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.05m.

For registered horses in Grades: A, B & C. Ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Pre enter through Horse Monkey and save. Entries will be accepted on the day.

Prizes: 1st: £35.00, 2nd: £25.00, 3rd: £18.00, 4th: £16.00, 5th: £16.00, Total: £110.00. **Entry Fee = £16.00 (Pre-Entry £14.00)**

Class 8 - Indoor Arena - **Connolly's RED MILLS Senior Newcomers - First Round/1.10m Open**

Rule 312. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.10m.

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Newcomers:

(a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 375 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 312.6

(b) For all horses born on or after 1st January 2013, irrespective of Points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of six years or under in the same calendar year as the Newcomers Final - in accordance with Rule 312.6.

Four double clears will qualify for the Senior Newcomers Second Rounds. Qualifying period 1st June - 31st May inclusive.

1.10m Open:

For registered horses ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

All horse/rider combinations eligible for the 1.10m National Amateur First Round will receive dual qualification of double clears, in either section of a Newcomer - first round/1.10m open competition. Held at Senior Category 1 shows only.

If combined with an open:

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money.

Pre enter through Horse Monkey and save. Entries will be accepted on the day.

Prizes: 1st: £40.00, 2nd: £25.00, 3rd: £20.00, 4th: £18.00, 5th: £18.00, Total: £121.00. **Entry Fee = £18.00 (Pre-Entry £16.00)**

Class 9 - Indoor Arena - National 1.15m Members Cup Qualifier/Senior 1.15m Open

Rule 294. Single Phase. Speed 350mpm. Start Height 1.15m.

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Open to registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who are not listed on the British Showjumping Gold League as of 31st March 2018.

Qualifies for: British Showjumping National Championships.

Qualification period: 1st June-31st May.

Numbers to qualify: Two double clears (subject to revision). Qualification is horse/rider combination.

Pre enter through Horse Monkey and save. Entries will be accepted on the day.

Prizes: 1st: £50.00, 2nd: £35.00, 3rd: £30.00, 4th: £25.00, 5th: £20.00, Total: £160.00. **Entry Fee = £20.00 (Pre-Entry £18.00)**
